Heritage Day Quiz – 20 April 2026

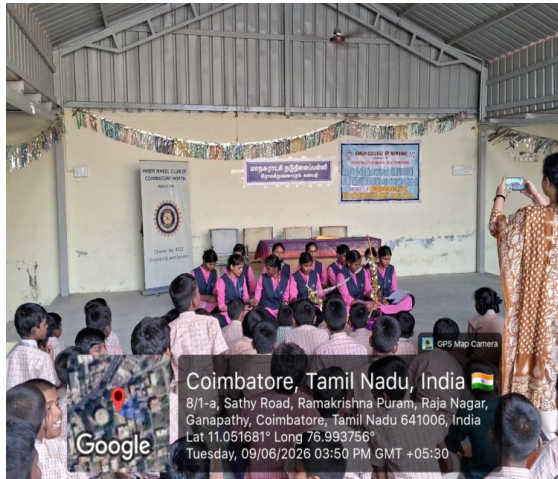
A Heritage Day Quiz was organized to strengthen students' knowledge of India's cultural heritage and historical legacy while promoting academic engagement and teamwork.

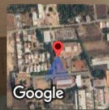

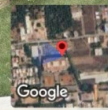


World Environment Day – 05 June 2026
